

WIN A SOUL A DAY (WASAD) | FIELD MANUAL

Motto: Every Day. One Soul. For the King.

📍 Section 1: The Core Mandate

The goal of **WASAD** is not to add numbers to a list, but to add/keep names to the Lamb's Book of Life. We believe that if every believer reaches just one person per day, the world will be reached in our generation.

The Three Pillars of a Soul Winner: The 3 Cs

- * **Consecration:** You cannot give what you do not have. Daily fellowship with Jesus is the fuel.
- * **Compassion:** We don't see "targets"; we see people for whom Christ died.
- * **Consistency:** Evangelism is not an event; it is a lifestyle. We don't wait for the "perfect moment"; we make the moment.

Section 2: The Practical "How-To"

Many people want to witness but don't know where to start. We use the **F.I.R.E.** method to ignite conversations.

F - Find the Person

- * **Pray:** "Holy Spirit, highlight the one you have prepared for me today."
- * **Look:** Identify the "person of peace" (*Luke 10:6*) - someone who is open, friendly, or even someone clearly in distress.

I - Initiate the Conversation

- * **Use a Prop:** Comment on a book they are holding, their shirt, or the weather.
- * **The Power of a Compliment:** Pay a sincere compliment. For example: "I noticed how kindly you spoke to that person. That's rare these days."

R - Reveal the Need

- * **Ask a Diagnostic Question:** "In your opinion, what is the greatest need in the world today?" or "Do you have a spiritual background?"
- * **Listen:** Let them talk for 70% of the time. Their answers tell you how to apply the Gospel (e.g., if they are lonely, emphasize God's presence).

E - Explain the Exchange

- * **The Core Message:** God is Holy. We are sinners. Jesus is the Savior. Faith is the Key.
- * **The Call to Action:** "Would you like to turn from your way, receive Jesus and follow Him from today?"

Section 3: The 5-Minute Gospel (The Bridge)

If you only have a few minutes, use this simple verbal illustration:

- * **The Gap:** God created us for a relationship, but our sin created a huge gap, a "grand canyon" between us and Him. (*Romans 3:23*)
- * **The Cross:** We tried to bridge the gap with good works or religion, but we failed. Jesus is the only bridge. (*Isaiah 64:6; 1 Timothy 2:5*)
- * **The Decision:** To cross the bridge, we must step onto it through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ. (*John 3:16*)



Section 4: The Global Scale Model

To grow from local to global, every **WASAD** member follows the **1-10-100 Rule**:

- * **1**: You win one soul a day.
- * **10**: You find 10 people in your local church or community to join the **WASAD** movement.
- * **100**: You train those 10 to each find 10 more, creating a "**Century Cell**" of 100 soul winners.

Section 5: Overcoming Obstacles

| **Obstacle** | **The WASAD Response** |

✓ **Section 6: Daily Reporting & Accountability**

A movement without accountability is just a dream. Every **WASAD** member should belong to a **FIRE Team** (3–5 people).

The Daily Report (The 3-2-1):

- * 3 minutes of prayer for the lost.
- * 2 spiritual seeds sown (conversations started).
- * 1 clear presentation of the Gospel.

Below is the **WASAD New Convert Follow-up Guide** so that those who get saved have a clear path to discipleship.

The **WASAD Follow-up Guide** (The First 7 Days) is designed to ensure that a new convert isn't just a statistic, but becomes a growing member of the Body of Christ.

THE WASAD NEW CONVERT 7-DAY FOLLOW-UP GUIDE

Winning a soul is the beginning; making a disciple is the mission.

Title: The First 7 Days: Starting Your Journey with Jesus

The Goal: To move a new believer from Decision to Discipleship through immediate connection and basic biblical grounding.

Step 0: The "Golden Hour" (Immediate Follow-up)

The first 60 minutes after a confession of faith are critical. Before you leave the new believer:

- * **Exchange Contact Info:** Do not leave without a phone number, email or social media handle.
- * **Give them a 'Sword':** If you have a physical Bible, give it to them. If not, help them download a Bible App with easy to understand versions, not just KJV.
- * **Schedule the First Call:** "I'm going to call you tomorrow just to check in. What time works best?"

The 7-Day Growth Plan

This can be sent via daily text messages or covered in two 30-minute meetings.

Day 1: Assurance of Salvation

* **Scripture:** John 1:12; Romans 10:9,10; 1 John 5:11-12.

* **The Key:** Salvation isn't based on a feeling; it's based on God's promise. If you have the Son, you have life.

* **Action:** **Ask them**, "Are you born-again?". Ensure they say yes. **Ask them** how they know and are sure they are born again. **Point them back to the scriptures** in this section. Their assurance of salvation must be based on the word, what God said, not their feeling, thinking or anything else. **Ask them**, "If you were to die tonight, where would you go?" **Ensure** they answer "Heaven" based on Jesus' work, not their own.

Day 2: Talking to Your Father (Prayer)

* **Scripture:** Exodus 33:11; Jeremiah 29:12; 33:3; Philippians 4:6; Matthew 6:7-13.

* **The Key:** Prayer is 'Conversation with God'. You talk to God like a friend and you listen to hear what God says. You may want to write down your conversations with God.

* **Action:** Encourage them to pray for 2 minutes today or as long as they want to - thanking God for saving them and to see what God says back to them. Demonstrate prayer and guide them to pray if meeting in person or over the phone/Zoom.

Day 3: Feeding Your Soul (The Word)

* **Scripture:** John 1; Psalm 119:105; 1 Peter 2:2.

* **The Key:** The Bible is spiritual food.

* **Action:** **Ask them** to read John Chapter 1. **Ask them** to text or email you one thing they learned about Jesus. **Guide them** into establishing a daily Bible reading system that works for them. Remember that the key is **consistency**, not rushing to read the whole Bible.

Day 4: The Clean Slate (Repentance & Grace)

* **Scripture:** Proverbs 28:13; 1 John 1:8-10; Romans 8:1.

* **The Key:** When we mess up, we don't run from God; we run to Him.

* **Action:** **Explain** that "Repentance" means a change of mind and direction. **The Holy Spirit convicts us** to run to God in repentance. **The devil condemns us** to run away from God in shame and separation from God which leads to spiritual death. **Compare** Peter and Judas in this regard.

Day 5: Finding Your Family (The Church)

- * **Scripture:** Ecclesiastes 4:9-12; 1 Corinthians 12:12-27; Hebrews 10:25.
- * **The Key:** A coal out of the fire goes cold. We need other believers.
- * **Action:** **Invite** them to your church service or small group this week. **Offer** to pick them up or make transport arrangements easy for them. If they are in a different location from you, **remind** them a day before and on the day. **Check in** after to find out how it went. **Ask** what stood out for them.

Day 6: The Public Declaration (Baptism)

- * **Scripture:** Matthew 28:9; Acts 2:41; 8:12, 35-38.
- * **The Key:** Baptism is an outward sign of an inward change. It's "going public" with your faith.
- * **Action:** **Explain** what baptism is and **ask** if they are ready to be baptized. **Arrange** their Baptism immediately. All that is required for baptism is salvation. The Bible describes baptism as **complete water immersion**, representing a spiritual cleansing and new life in Christ. **Jesus' Example:** Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan River setting an example for believers.

Day 7: Joining the Mission (WASAD)

- * **Scripture:** Mark 16:15; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 9:1–19a; 22:1–21; 26:9–23.
- * **The Key:** You are saved to serve! You now have a story to tell.
- * **Action:** Ask them, "Who is one person you know who needs to hear what happened to you this week?" Help them share their testimony with that person.

The "Hand-Off" Table

As the **WASAD** soul-winner, you are the "midwife," but the local church is the "nursery."


Use this checklist:

Pro-Tip for WASAD Leaders:

Create a "New Convert Starter Pack" (digital or physical). It should contain:

- * A copy of the Gospel of John.
- * A "Welcome Home" card with your contact info.
- * A simple list of 5 local Bible-believing churches in your city.
- * If a convert is in another location, do not end the conversation without finding a local Bible-believing church or ministry near them.
